"The code of criminal procedure,"

(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 10c to chapter II.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 CHAPTER II
- Sec. 10c. (1) <<Conduct prohibited under former section 285 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, or a>> violation of the identity theft protection
- 3 act, or a violation of law committed in furtherance of or arising
- 4 from the same transaction as <<conduct prohibited under former section 285 of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, or>> a violation of the identity theft
- 5 protection act, may be prosecuted in 1 of the following
- 6 jurisdictions:
- 7 (a) The jurisdiction in which the offense occurred.
- 8 (b) The jurisdiction in which the information used to commit
- 9 the violation was illegally used.
- 10 (c) The jurisdiction in which the victim resides.
- 11 (2) If a person is charged with more than 1 violation of the

- 2 prosecuted in more than 1 jurisdiction, any of those
- 3 jurisdictions is a proper jurisdiction for all of the violations.
