## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8313. (1) A violation of state criminal law shall be prosecuted in the district court by the prosecuting attorney. A 2 violation of an ordinance of a political subdivision that is a 3 misdemeanor or that is not designated as a civil infraction shall 4 5 be prosecuted in the district court by the attorney for the political subdivision whose ordinance was violated. 6 If the violation is a civil infraction, the prosecuting attorney or 7 attorney for the political subdivision shall appear in court only 8 9 in those civil infraction actions that are contested before a 10 judge of the district court in a formal hearing as provided in
