## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 5842

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending sections 617, 617a, 618, and 619 (MCL 257.617,

257.617a, 257.618, and 257.619), section 617 as amended by 2001 PA 159 and section 619 as amended by 1999 PA 73.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 617. (1) The driver of a vehicle who knows or who has reason to believe that he or she has been involved in an accident upon <u>either</u> public or private property <u>, when the property</u> that is open to travel by the public <u>, resulting in serious</u> <u>impairment of a body function or death of a person</u> shall immediately stop his or her vehicle at the scene of the accident and shall remain there until the requirements of section 619 are fulfilled. The stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), <u>a person who</u>
 violates if the individual fails to comply with subsection (1)
 and the accident results in serious impairment of a body function
 or death, the individual is guilty of a felony punishable by
 imprisonment for not more than 5 years or by a fine of not more
