For a transcript ordered by the circuit judge, 5 6 reporters or recorders -shall be are entitled to receive from 7 the county the same compensation. The supreme court, by administrative order or court rule, may authorize the payment to 8 circuit court reporters or recorders the sum of \$3.00 per 9 10 original page and 50 cents for each copy for transcripts ordered
