1 Sec. 316. (1) A person who commits any of the following is quilty of first degree murder and shall be punished by

 - (b) Murder committed in the perpetration of, or attempt to perpetrate, arson, criminal sexual conduct in the first, second, or third degree, child abuse in the first degree, a major controlled substance offense, robbery, carjacking, breaking and entering of a dwelling, home invasion in the first or second

- 1 degree, larceny of any kind, extortion, -or kidnapping, or
