THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- "social security number privacy act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act, "person" means an individual,
 - partnership, limited liability company, trust, custodian, estate,
- 5 association, corporation, public or private elementary or
- 6 secondary school, trade school, vocational school, community or
- junior college, college, university, or other governmental or
- legal entity.
 - Sec. 3. A person shall not disclose to a third party or
- publicly display all or any part of the social security number of

- 1 consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is
- 2 authorized by law.
- 3 Sec. 4. (1) A person who violates this act is responsible
- 4 for the payment of a civil fine of not more than \$1,000.00.
- 5 (2) A person who knowingly violates this act is guilty of a
- 6 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days
- 7 or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 8 (3) An individual may bring a civil action against a person
- 9 who violates this act and may recover actual damages or
- 10 \$1,000.00, whichever is greater, plus reasonable attorney fees.
