THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 208. (1) Services provided by a community mental
- 2 health services program shall be directed to individuals who have
- 3 a serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbance, or
- 4 developmental disability.
- 5 (2) Services may be directed to individuals who have other
- 6 mental disorders that meet criteria specified in the most recent
- 7 diagnostic and statistical manual of mental health disorders
- 8 published by the American psychiatric association and may also be
- 9 directed to the prevention of mental disability and the promotion
- 10 of mental health. Resources that have been specifically

- 1 designated to community mental health services programs for
- 2 services to individuals with dementia, alcoholism, or substance
