A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 32513 (MCL 324.32513), as amended by 2012 PA
247.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 32513. (1) To obtain a permit for any work or connection
- 2 specified in section 32512, a person shall file an application with
- 3 the department on a form provided by the department. The
- 4 application shall include all of the following:
- 5 (a) The name and address of the applicant.
- 6 (b) The legal description of the lands included in the
- 7 project.
- 8 (c) A summary statement of the purpose of the project.
- 9 (d) A map or diagram showing the proposal on an adequate scale

- 1 with contours and cross-section profiles of any waterway to be
- 2 constructed.
- 3 (e) Other information required by the department.
- 4 (2) Except as provided in subsections (3) and (4), until
- 5 October 1, 2015, an application for a permit under this section
- 6 shall be accompanied by the following fee, as applicable:
- 7 (a) For a project in a category of activities for which a
- 8 general permit is issued under section 32512a, a fee of \$100.00.
- 9 (b) For activities included in a minor project category, a fee
- **10** of \$50.00.
- 11 (c) For construction or expansion of a marina, a fee of:
- 12 (i) \$50.00 for an expansion of 1-10 slips to an existing
- 13 permitted marina.
- (ii) \$100.00 for a new marina with 1-10 proposed marina slips.
- 15 (iii) \$250.00 for an expansion of 11-50 slips to an existing
- 16 permitted marina, plus \$10.00 for each slip over 50.
- (iv) \$500.00 for a new marina with 11-50 proposed marina slips,
- 18 plus \$10.00 for each slip over 50.
- 19 (v) \$1,500.00 if an existing permitted marina proposes
- 20 maintenance dredging of 10,000 cubic yards or more, UNLESS THE
- 21 DREDGE MATERIAL HAS BEEN DETERMINED THROUGH TESTING TO BE 90% OR
- 22 MORE SAND, or the addition of seawalls, bulkheads, or revetments of
- 23 500 feet or more.
- 24 (d) For major projects other than a project described in
- 25 subdivision (c) (v), involving any of the following, a fee of
- 26 \$2,000.00:
- 27 (i) Dredging of 10,000 cubic yards or more, UNLESS THE DREDGE

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## 1 MATERIAL HAS BEEN DETERMINED THROUGH TESTING TO BE 90% OR MORE

- 2 SAND.
- 3 (ii) Filling of 10,000 cubic yards or more.
- 4 (iii) Seawalls, bulkheads, or revetment of 500 feet or more.
- 5 (iv) Filling or draining of 1 acre or more of coastal wetland.
- (v) New dredging or upland boat basin excavation in areas of
- 7 suspected contamination.
- 8 (vi) New breakwater or channel jetty.
- 9 (vii) Shore protection, such as groins and underwater
- 10 stabilizers, that extend 150 feet or more on Great Lakes
- 11 bottomlands.
- 12 (viii) New commercial dock or wharf of 300 feet or more in
- 13 length.
- 14 (e) For all other projects not listed in subdivisions (a) to
- **15** (d), \$500.00.
- 16 (3) A project that requires review and approval under this
- 17 part and 1 or more of the following is subject to only the single
- 18 highest permit fee required under this part or the following:
- **19** (a) Part 301.
- **20** (b) Part 303.
- **21** (c) Part 323.
- 22 (d) Section 3104.
- 23 (e) Section 117 of the land division act, 1967 PA 288, MCL
- **24** 560.117.
- 25 (4) If work has been done in violation of a permit requirement
- 26 under this part and restoration is not ordered by the department,
- 27 the department may accept an application for a permit if the

- 1 application is accompanied by a fee equal to 2 times the permit fee
- 2 otherwise required under this section.
- 3 (5) The department shall forward all fees collected under this
- 4 section to the state treasurer for deposit into the land and water
- 5 management permit fee fund created in section 30113.
