HOUSE BILL No. 4297

February 20, 2013, Introduced by Rep. Foster and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending sections 74101, 74116, and 78119 (MCL 324.74101,
324.74116, and 324.78119), sections 74101 and 74116 as amended by
2010 PA 33 and section 78119 as added by 2010 PA 34.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 74101. As used in this part:
- (a) "Commercial motor vehicle" means a commercial vehicle as
 defined in section 7 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL
 257.7.
 - (B) "DISABLED VETERAN" MEANS A RESIDENT WHO SERVED IN THE
 - ARMY, AIR FORCE, NAVY, MARINE CORPS, OR COAST GUARD, WHO WAS
- 7 RELEASED FROM HIS OR HER MILITARY SERVICE WITH AN HONORABLE OR
 - GENERAL DISCHARGE, AND WHO, AS DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES

- 1 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, IS AT LEAST 30% DISABLED AS A
- 2 RESULT OF MILITARY SERVICE AND ENTITLED TO VETERANS' BENEFITS.
- 3 (C) (b) "Improvement program" means the construction,
- 4 reconstruction, development, improvement, bettering, operating,
- 5 maintaining, and extending a facility at a state park, including a
- 6 site improvement, impoundment, road and parking lot, toilet
- 7 building, concession building, shelter building, bathhouse,
- 8 utility, outdoor center, visitor service facility, ski area, ski
- 9 tow, ski shelter, and administration unit.
- 10 (D) (c) "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is self-
- 11 propelled.
- 12 (E) (d) "Nonresident motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle
- 13 other than a commercial motor vehicle that is not registered as a
- 14 motor vehicle in this state.
- (F) (e) "Recreation passport fee" means that term as defined
- 16 in section 2001.
- 17 (G) (f) "Resident motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle other
- 18 than a commercial motor vehicle that is registered as a motor
- 19 vehicle in this state.
- 20 (H) (g) "State park" means a state park or state recreation
- 21 area designated by the director.
- 22 (I) (h) "State park improvement account" means the state park
- 23 improvement account of the Michigan conservation and recreation
- 24 legacy fund provided for in section 2030.
- 25 (J) (i) "State park revenues" means all revenues collected for
- 26 state parks, including but not limited to, revenue from recreation
- 27 passport fees, motor vehicle permits, concession fees, nonmotorized

- 1 trail permits, fees, leases, camping fees, sale of farm animals
- 2 from Maybury state park, donations, and gifts.
- 3 Sec. 74116. (1) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND
- 4 (5), the operator of a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial
- 5 motor vehicle shall not enter any state park with that motor
- 6 vehicle unless a valid motor vehicle park permit issued under
- 7 section 74117 is affixed to the lower right-hand corner of the
- 8 windshield. An annual motor vehicle park permit for a nonresident
- 9 motor vehicle shall be affixed permanently for that year. The
- 10 department shall post signs at parks that state that a motor
- 11 vehicle permit is required for entry by a nonresident motor vehicle
- 12 or commercial motor vehicle.
- 13 (2) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), the
- 14 operator of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a state park
- 15 with the resident motor vehicle unless the recreation passport fee
- 16 has been paid for that motor vehicle.
- 17 (3) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), if the
- 18 secretary of state issues registration tabs or stickers as
- 19 described in section 805 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,
- 20 MCL 257.805, the operator of a resident motor vehicle shall not
- 21 enter a state park with the resident motor vehicle unless the
- 22 resident motor vehicle has a registration tab or sticker or
- 23 temporary registration plate marked as provided under that section
- 24 to show that the recreation passport fee has been paid.
- 25 (4) The requirements of subsections—SUBSECTIONS (1) to (3) do
- 26 not apply under any of the following circumstances:
- 27 (a) While the motor vehicle is being driven or parked within

- 1 an established federal, state, or county highway within a state
- 2 park.
- 3 (b) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 4 maintenance of a state park, is an emergency motor vehicle, is a
- 5 state owned or law enforcement motor vehicle, or is a private motor
- 6 vehicle being operated on official state business.
- 7 (c) If and to the extent the department waives the
- 8 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 9 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- 10 (5) SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (3) DO NOT APPLY IF A DISABLED VETERAN
- 11 ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT IS AFFIXED TO THE LOWER RIGHT-HAND
- 12 CORNER OF THE WINDSHIELD. THE DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE
- 13 PARK PERMIT SHALL BE AFFIXED PERMANENTLY FOR THE YEAR. THE
- 14 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK
- 15 PERMIT FREE OF CHARGE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UPON PRESENTATION OF PROOF
- 16 ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A DISABLED
- 17 VETERAN. A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT
- 18 AUTHORIZES THE ENTRY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH IT IS ORIGINALLY
- 19 ATTACHED WITHIN ANY STATE PARK DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR FOR WHICH
- 20 IT IS ISSUED. A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT
- 21 SHALL NOT BE USED FOR A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 22 Sec. 78119. (1) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND
- 23 (5), a person shall not enter, in a nonresident motor vehicle or
- 24 commercial motor vehicle, a designated state-operated public
- 25 boating access site without a valid pass affixed to the lower
- 26 right-hand corner of the windshield. A seasonal pass shall be
- 27 affixed permanently for the season.

- 1 (2) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), the
- 2 operator of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a designated
- 3 state-operated public boating access site with the resident motor
- 4 vehicle unless the recreation passport fee has been paid for that
- 5 motor vehicle.
- 6 (3) Subject to subsection (4), SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), if the
- 7 secretary of state issues registration tabs or stickers as
- 8 described in section 805 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,
- 9 MCL 257.805, the operator of a resident motor vehicle shall not
- 10 enter a designated state-operated public boating access site with
- 11 the resident motor vehicle unless the resident motor vehicle has a
- 12 registration tab or sticker or temporary registration plate marked
- 13 as provided under that section to show that the recreation passport
- 14 fee has been paid.
- 15 (4) The requirements of subsections SUBSECTIONS (1) to (3) do
- 16 not apply under any of the following circumstances:
- 17 (a) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 18 maintenance of the public boating access site, is an emergency
- 19 motor vehicle, is a state-owned or law enforcement motor vehicle,
- 20 or is a private motor vehicle being operated on official state
- 21 business.
- (b) If and to the extent the department waives the
- 23 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 24 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- 25 (5) SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (3) DO NOT APPLY IF A DISABLED VETERAN
- 26 ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT IS AFFIXED TO THE LOWER RIGHT-HAND
- 27 CORNER OF THE WINDSHIELD. THE DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE

- 1 PARK PERMIT SHALL BE AFFIXED PERMANENTLY FOR THE YEAR. THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK
- 3 PERMIT FREE OF CHARGE TO AN INDIVIDUAL UPON PRESENTATION OF PROOF
- 4 ACCEPTABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A DISABLED
- 5 VETERAN. A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT
- 6 AUTHORIZES THE ENTRY OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO WHICH IT IS ORIGINALLY
- 7 ATTACHED WITHIN ANY STATE PARK DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR FOR WHICH
- 8 IT IS ISSUED. A DISABLED VETERAN ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE PARK PERMIT
- 9 SHALL NOT BE USED FOR A COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.
- 10 (6) $\frac{(5)}{}$ A person who violates subsection (1), (2), or (3) is
- 11 responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay
- 12 a civil fine of not more than \$100.00. A person shall not be cited
- 13 for a violation of both subsections (2) and (3) for the same
- 14 incident.
- 15 (7) (6)—In any proceeding for the violation of this part or a
- 16 rule promulgated under this part, if a motor vehicle is found
- 17 parked in a designated state-operated public boating access site,
- 18 the registration plate displayed on the motor vehicle constitutes
- 19 prima facie evidence that the owner of the motor vehicle was the
- 20 person who parked or placed it at the location where it was found.
