A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending section 32513 (MCL 324.32513), as amended by 2012 PA 247.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 32513. (1) To obtain a permit for any work or connection specified in section 32512, a person shall file an application with the department on a form provided by the department. The application shall include all of the following:

(a) The name and address of the applicant.

(c) A summary statement of the purpose of the project.

(d) A map or diagram showing the proposal on an adequate scale
 with contours and cross-section profiles of any waterway to be

5 (2) Except as provided in subsections (3) and (4), until
6 October 1, 2015, an application for a permit under this section
7 shall be accompanied by the following fee, as applicable:

8 (a) For a project in a category of activities for which a
9 general permit is issued under section 32512a, a fee of \$100.00.

10 (b) For activities included in a minor project category, a fee11 of \$50.00.

12 (c) For construction or expansion of a marina, a fee of:

13 (i) \$50.00 for an expansion of 1-10 slips to an existing14 permitted marina.

(*ii*) \$100.00 for a new marina with 1-10 proposed marina slips.
(*iii*) \$250.00 for an expansion of 11-50 slips to an existing
permitted marina, plus \$10.00 for each slip over 50.

18 (*iv*) \$500.00 for a new marina with 11-50 proposed marina slips,
19 plus \$10.00 for each slip over 50.

(v) \$1,500.00 if an existing permitted marina proposes
 maintenance dredging of 10,000 cubic yards or more, UNLESS THE
 DREDGE MATERIAL HAS BEEN DETERMINED THROUGH TESTING TO BE 90% OR
 MORE SAND, or the addition of seawalls, bulkheads, or revetments of
 500 feet or more.

25 (d) For major projects other than a project described in
26 subdivision (c) (v), involving any of the following, a fee of
27 \$2,000.00:

(F) (e) For all other projects not listed in subdivisions (a)
 to (d), (E), \$500.00.

(4) If work has been done in violation of a permit requirement
under this part and restoration is not ordered by the department,
the department may accept an application for a permit if the
application is accompanied by a fee equal to 2 times the permit fee
otherwise required under this section.

9 management permit fee fund created in section 30113.
