

House Bill 4781 (Substitute H-2 as reported without amendment) Sponsor: Representative Holly Hughes House Committee: Tourism and Outdoor Recreation Senate Committee: Outdoor Recreation and Tourism

<u>CONTENT</u>

The bill would amend Part 721 (Michigan Trailways) of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to do the following:

- -- Allow an individual to operate a class 1 electric bicycle on a linear trail with an asphalt, crushed limestone, or similar surface, or a rail trail.
- -- Allow an individual to operate a class 2 or class 3 electric bicycle on a linear trail with an asphalt, crushed limestone, or similar surface, or a rail trail, if authorized by the local authority or State agency having jurisdiction over the trail.
- -- Prohibit the operation of an electric bike on a trail specifically designated as nonmotorized, unless allowed by the local authority or State agency with jurisdiction over the trail.
- -- Specify that these provisions would not apply to the use of electric bicycles on a congressionally authorized public trail system.
