A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961,"

by amending section 1344 (MCL 600.1344), as amended by 2002 PA 739.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1344. (1) A juror shall MUST be reimbursed for his or her 1 2 traveling expenses at a rate, determined by the county board of 3 commissioners, that is not less than 10 cents per mile OR, BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2018, NOT LESS THAN 20 CENTS PER MILE for 4 5 traveling from the juror's residence to the place of holding court 6 and returning for each day or 1/2 day of actual attendance at 7 sessions of the court. 8 (2) A juror also shall MUST be compensated at a rate, 9 determined by the county board of commissioners, as follows:

10 (a) Until October 1, 2003, not less than \$15.00 per day and

1 \$7.50 per 1/2 day of actual attendance at the court.

2 (A) (b) Beginning October 1, 2003, a EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
3 SUBDIVISION (B), A rate determined as follows:

4 (i) For the first day or 1/2 day of actual attendance at the
5 court, not less than \$25.00 per day and \$12.50 per 1/2 day.

6 (ii) For each subsequent day or 1/2 day of actual attendance
7 at the court, not less than \$40.00 per day and \$20.00 per 1/2 day.

8 (B) BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2018, AND EVERY SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR, 9 IF, AS OF THE END OF THE 2 MOST RECENT FISCAL YEARS, THE STATE 10 COURT ADMINISTRATOR, AT THE DIRECTION OF THE SUPREME COURT AND UPON 11 CONFIRMATION BY THE STATE TREASURER, DETERMINES THAT SUFFICIENT 12 FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE JUROR COMPENSATION REIMBURSEMENT FUND 13 CREATED IN SECTION 151D, A RATE DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

14 (*i*) FOR THE FIRST DAY OR 1/2 DAY OF ACTUAL ATTENDANCE AT THE 15 COURT, NOT LESS THAN \$30.00 PER DAY AND \$15.00 PER 1/2 DAY.

16 (*ii*) FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT DAY OR 1/2 DAY OF ACTUAL ATTENDANCE 17 AT THE COURT, NOT LESS THAN \$45.00 PER DAY AND \$22.50 PER 1/2 DAY.

18 (3) If an action is removed from the circuit court to a lower 19 court, the jury fee shall MUST be paid to the circuit court whether 20 paid before or after removal of the action to the lower court, and 21 the circuit court shall be IS responsible for payment of the 22 compensation to the juror involved.

(4) A clerk or deputy clerk of the court who fraudulently
issues a certificate of attendance of a juror on which the juror
receives pay, except as allowed by law, is guilty of a misdemeanor
, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 6 months , or a fine
of not more than \$500.00, or both.
