HOUSE BILL No. 4173

February 7, 2017, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Lucido, Canfield, Cox, Tedder, Webber, Kahle and Glenn and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1979 PA 218, entitled
"Adult foster care facility licensing act,"
by amending sections 6 and 26a (MCL 400.706 and 400.726a), section
6 as amended by 1998 PA 442 and section 26a as added by 1996 PA
194, and by adding section 26c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6. (1) "Personal care" means personal assistance provided
 by a licensee or an agent or employee of a licensee to a resident
 who requires assistance with dressing, personal hygiene, grooming,
 maintenance of a medication schedule as directed and supervised by
 the resident's physician, or the development of those personal and
 social skills required to live in the least restrictive
 environment.
 - (2) "Physical disability" means a determinable physical characteristic of an individual that may result from disease,

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- 1 injury, congenital condition of birth, or functional disorder.
- 2 (3) "Physical plant" means the structure in which a facility
- 3 is located and all physical appurtenances to the facility.
- 4 (4) "PHYSICIAN ORDERS FOR SCOPE OF TREATMENT FORM" OR "POST
- 5 FORM" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 5674 OF THE PUBLIC
- 6 HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5674.
- 7 (5) $\frac{(4)}{}$ "Protection", subject to section 26a(2), means the
- 8 continual responsibility of the licensee to take reasonable action
- 9 to insure ENSURE the health, safety, and well-being of a resident,
- 10 including protection from physical harm, humiliation, intimidation,
- 11 and social, moral, financial, and personal exploitation while on
- 12 the premises, while under the supervision of the licensee or an
- 13 agent or employee of the licensee, or when the resident's
- 14 assessment plan states that the resident needs continuous
- 15 supervision.
- 16 (6) (5) "Provisional license" means a license issued to a
- 17 facility that has previously been licensed under this act or an act
- 18 repealed by this act but is temporarily unable to conform to the
- 19 requirements of a regular license prescribed in this act or rules
- 20 promulgated under this act.
- 21 (7) (6) "Quality of care" means the foster care of residents
- 22 of a facility and other similar items not related to the physical
- 23 plant that address themselves to the general physical and mental
- 24 health, welfare, and well-being of residents.
- 25 Sec. 26a. (1) A resident of an adult foster care facility who
- 26 is enrolled in a licensed hospice program is not considered to
- 27 require continuous nursing care for purposes of section 3(4).

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- 1 (2) A licensee providing foster care to a resident who is
- 2 enrolled in a licensed hospice program and whose assessment plan
- 3 includes a do-not-resuscitate order OR A VALIDLY EXECUTED POST FORM
- 4 UNDER PART 56B OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5671
- 5 TO 333.5685, is considered to be providing protection to the
- 6 resident for purposes of section $\frac{6(4)}{6(5)}$ and the rules
- 7 promulgated under this act if, in the event the resident suffers
- 8 cessation of both spontaneous respiration and circulation, the
- 9 licensee contacts the licensed hospice program.
- 10 SEC. 26C. (1) AN ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITY SHALL COMPLY WITH
- 11 MEDICAL ORDERS PROVIDED ON A VALIDLY EXECUTED POST FORM AS REQUIRED
- 12 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PART 56B OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA
- 13 368, MCL 333.5671 TO 333.5685.
- 14 (2) IF AN ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITY IS UNWILLING TO COMPLY
- 15 WITH THE MEDICAL ORDERS PROVIDED ON A VALIDLY EXECUTED FORM BECAUSE
- 16 OF A POLICY, RELIGIOUS BELIEF, OR MORAL CONVICTION, THE ADULT
- 17 FOSTER CARE FACILITY SHALL TAKE ALL REASONABLE STEPS TO REFER OR
- 18 TRANSFER THE PATIENT TO ANOTHER ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITY.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 20 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 21 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 22 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 4170 (request no.
- 23 00360'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.

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
