HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 901

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 18001 (MCL 333.18001), as amended by 2016 PA 379.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18001. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Medical care services" means those services within the
- 3 scope of practice of podiatrists PODIATRIC PHYSICIANS licensed by
- 4 the board, except those services that the board prohibits or
- 5 otherwise restricts within a practice agreement or determines shall
- 6 not be delegated by a podiatrist PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN without
- 7 endangering the health and safety of patients as provided for in
- **8** section 18048.

- 1 (b) "Participating podiatrist" means a podiatrist PODIATRIC
- 2 PHYSICIAN or a podiatrist PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN designated by a group
- 3 of podiatrists-PODIATRIC PHYSICIANS under section 18049 to
- 4 represent that group.
- 5 (c) "Podiatrist" "PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN" means a physician and
- 6 surgeon AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS licensed under this article to engage
- 7 in the practice of podiatric medicine and **PODIATRIC** surgery.
- 8 (d) "Practice agreement" means an agreement described in
- **9** section 18047.
- 10 (e) "Practice as a physician's assistant" means the practice
- 11 of podiatric medicine and **PODIATRIC** surgery with a participating
- 12 podiatrist PODIATRIC PHYSICIAN under a practice agreement.
- 13 (f) "Practice EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (G),
- 14 "PRACTICE of podiatric medicine and PODIATRIC surgery" means the
- 15 examination, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (i) THE EVALUATION, diagnosis, MANAGEMENT, and treatment
- 17 PREVENTION of abnormal nails, superficial excrescenses occurring on
- 18 the human hands and feet, including corns, warts, callosities, and
- 19 bunions, and arch troubles or the treatment medically, surgically,
- 20 mechanically, or by physiotherapy of ailments of human feet or
- 21 ankles as they affect the condition of the feet. It does not
- 22 include amputation of human feet, or the use or administration of
- 23 anesthetics other than local. CONDITIONS OF THE LOWER EXTREMITIES,
- 24 INCLUDING LOCAL MANIFESTATIONS OF SYSTEMIC DISEASE IN THE HUMAN
- 25 FOOT AND ANKLE, BY ATTENDING TO AND ADVISING PATIENTS AND THROUGH
- 26 THE USE OF DEVICES, DIAGNOSTIC TESTS, DRUGS AND BIOLOGICALS,
- 27 SURGICAL PROCEDURES, OR OTHER MEANS. THE EVALUATION, DIAGNOSIS,

- MANAGEMENT, AND PREVENTION OF CONDITIONS OF THE LOWER EXTREMITIES 1
- 2 MAY INCLUDE OSSEOUS AND SOFT TISSUE PROCEDURES THAT ADDRESS THE
- PATHOLOGY OF THE FOOT, ANKLE, AND THE CONTIGUOUS ATTACHMENTS BELOW 3
- THE TIBIAL TUBEROSITY. 4
- 5 (ii) THE TREATMENT OF ULCERATIONS BELOW THE TIBIAL TUBEROSITY
- 6 AND OF HUMAN NAIL DISEASES, CALLOSITIES, AND VERRUCA.
- (G) "PRACTICE OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE AND PODIATRIC SURGERY" 7
- DOES NOT INCLUDE AMPUTATIONS PROXIMAL TO THE TIBIOTALAR JOINT, 8
- PROXIMAL OSSEOUS PROCEDURES THAT DO NOT INVOLVE THE TIBIOTALAR 9
- JOINT, OR THE ADMINISTRATION OF INTRAVENOUS SEDATION OR GENERAL 10
- 11 ANESTHESIA.
- 12 (H) (g) "Task force" means the joint task force created in
- section 17025. 13
- 14 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 15 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 16 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
- 17 definitions applicable to this part.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
