HOUSE BILL No. 5917

May 1, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Vaupel and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to prohibit a local unit of government from enacting or enforcing an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a qualified pet shop located in that local unit of government; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain local officers and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. (1) The governing body of a local unit of government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule that regulates a qualified pet shop located in that local unit of government.

(2) Any provision in an ordinance, policy, resolution, or rule adopted by the governing body of a local unit of government on or
