March 8, 2018, Introduced by Senators STAMAS, SHIRKEY, HUNE, MARLEAU, KNEZEK, HERTEL and ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 18001 (MCL 333.18001), as amended by 2016 PA 379.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18001. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Medical care services" means those services within the
- 3 scope of practice of podiatrists licensed by the board, except
- 4 those services that the board prohibits or otherwise restricts
- 5 within a practice agreement or determines shall not be delegated by
- 6 a podiatrist without endangering the health and safety of patients
- 7 as provided for in section 18048.
 - (b) "Participating podiatrist" means a podiatrist or a
 - podiatrist designated by a group of podiatrists under section 18049

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- 1 to represent that group.
- 2 (c) "Podiatrist" means a physician and surgeon licensed under
- 3 this article to engage in the practice of podiatric medicine and
- 4 surgery.
- 5 (d) "Practice agreement" means an agreement described in
- 6 section 18047.
- 7 (e) "Practice as a physician's assistant" means the practice
- 8 of podiatric medicine and surgery with a participating podiatrist
- 9 under a practice agreement.
- 10 (f) "Practice EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (G),
- 11 "PRACTICE of podiatric medicine and surgery" means the examination,
- 12 ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (i) THE EVALUATION, diagnosis, MANAGEMENT, and treatment
- 14 PREVENTION of abnormal nails, superficial excrescenses occurring on
- 15 the human hands and feet, including corns, warts, callosities, and
- 16 bunions, and arch troubles or the treatment medically, surgically,
- 17 mechanically, or by physiotherapy of ailments of human feet or
- 18 ankles as they affect the condition of the feet. It does not
- 19 include amputation of human feet, or the use or administration of
- 20 anesthetics other than local. CONDITIONS OF THE LOWER EXTREMITIES,
- 21 INCLUDING LOCAL MANIFESTATIONS OF SYSTEMIC CONDITIONS, AFFECTING
- 22 THE GOVERNING AND RELATED STRUCTURE OF THE HUMAN FOOT AND ANKLE
- 23 DISTAL TO THE TIBIAL TUBERCLE, BY ATTENDING TO AND ADVISING
- 24 PATIENTS AND THROUGH THE USE OF DEVICES, DIAGNOSTIC TESTS, DRUGS
- 25 AND BIOLOGICALS, SURGICAL PROCEDURES, OR OTHER MEANS.
- 26 (ii) THE TREATMENT OF ULCERATIONS BELOW THE KNEE AND OF NAIL
- 27 DISEASES AND SUPERFICIAL EXCRESCENCES OCCURRING ON THE HUMAN HANDS.

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- 1 (G) "PRACTICE OF PODIATRIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY" DOES NOT
- 2 INCLUDE AMPUTATIONS AT OR ABOVE THE TIBIOTALAR JOINT OR THE
- 3 ADMINISTRATION OF DEEP SEDATION OR GENERAL ANESTHESIA.
- 4 (H) (g) "Task force" means the joint task force created in
- **5** section 17025.
- 6 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 7 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 8 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains
- 9 definitions applicable to this part.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
