THE MANUFACTURING PROCESS AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 109(1).

(B) THE PURCHASING OR RECEIVING SMALL WINE MAKER BOTTLES THE
 PURCHASED OR RECEIVED WINE.

(C) THE PURCHASING OR RECEIVING WINE MAKER OR SMALL WINE MAKER
IS SELLING A SHINER AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 111(10) ON
WHICH THE WINE MAKER OR SMALL WINE MAKER HAS PLACED A LABEL
PURSUANT TO SECTION 111(10).
