Summary

Senate Bill 352 would designate March 31 of each year as “Cesar E. Chavez Day” in the State of Michigan, in recognition of the fundamental contribution that he made to this nation. Cesar E. Chavez organized farm workers to campaign for safe and fair working conditions, reasonable wages, decent housing, and the outlawing of child labor. Also, he crusaded against racial and economic discrimination, coordinated voter registration drives, and founded the United Farm Workers of America.

Fiscal Impact

Senate Bill 352 would have no fiscal impact on the State or on local units of government.
