**Analysis**

**Summary**

House Bill 4495 (H-3) would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to establish requirements for certain handicapper parking spaces. Failure to comply with those requirement would result in a civil infraction and a fine of \$100, with an additional fine of \$100 for each 30-day period after a citation were issued during which the violation remained uncured. The total fine amount could not exceed \$1,000.

**Fiscal Impact**

The bill would increase the amount of fine revenue earmarked for distribution to local libraries pursuant to section 8379 of the Revised Judicature Act of 1961. The magnitude of this increase is indeterminate.
