### **Analysis**

#### **Summary**

The bill would amend the Public Health Code to clarify that “medical first responder” does not include a police officer solely because his or her police vehicle is equipped with an automated external defibrillator.

“Medical first responder” is an individual who has met the educational requirements of a medical first responder course approved by the department and who is licensed to provide medical first response life support as part of a medical first response service or as a driver of an ambulance that provides basic life support services only.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the State or on local governmental units.
