### **Analysis**

#### **Summary**

This bill would establish a wildlife violator compact with other states. The Department of Natural Resources would be responsible for the maintenance of a violator data base to be shared with regulatory agencies in other states. This same information from other states would be available to the State of Michigan. Under such a compact, it would be possible to deny a hunting or fishing license to a person found to have violated a game or fish law in another state.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

There would be no fiscal impact on the State or on local governmental units.
