Analysis

Summary

This bill would provide free daily permits for use of Michigan State Parks to individuals who have served in Iraq or Afghanistan. Free day use permits would be issued for the 2004 year only, and would apply to any vehicle normally assessed a \$4.00 fee (resident) or \$6.00 fee (nonresident).

Fiscal Impact

There would be an indeterminate impact on State Park revenues. The actual revenue loss would depend on the number of eligible servicemen seeking admittance to a State Park during the 2004 calendar year. There would be no fiscal impact on local governmental units.
