

SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 6025

A bill to establish the united way fund in the department of treasury; to establish the children's hospital of Michigan fund in the department of community health; to provide for the distribution of the money from those funds; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

PART 1

Sec. 1. This part shall be known and may be cited as the "united way fund act".

Sec. 2. As used in this act:

(a) "Department" means the department of treasury.

1 (b) "Fund" means the united way fund created in section 3.

2 Sec. 3. (1) The united way fund is created in the department
3 to provide funds for donation to any united way of America
4 organization located in this state to improve lives by mobilizing
5 the caring power of communities to provide for basic needs,
6 including, but not limited to, food, clothing, and shelter.

7 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
8 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
9 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.

10 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
11 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
12 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
13 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
14 things of value received by the fund.

15 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
16 fund.

17 Sec. 4. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund
18 shall be expended solely for the purposes described in this act.

19 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the
20 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation to each
21 county from which a contribution, gift, or donation was received.

22 Sec. 5. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for
23 a federal grant if those funds are to be used for the purposes
24 described under section 3 only if the federal grant will benefit
25 the county from which the matching funds were received.

26 Sec. 6. The money in the fund that is available for
27 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money in the fund at

1 the close of the year shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse
2 to the general fund.

3 PART 2

4 Sec. 11. This part shall be known and may be cited as the
5 "children's hospital of Michigan fund act".

6 Sec. 13. As used in this part:

7 (a) "Department" means the department of community health.

8 (b) "Fund" means the children's hospital of Michigan fund
9 created in section 15.

10 Sec. 15. (1) The children's hospital of Michigan fund is
11 created in the department to provide funds for donation to the
12 children's hospital of Michigan to support the children's hospital
13 of Michigan in providing life-saving pediatric care, education, and
14 research.

15 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
16 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
17 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other
18 source for deposit into the fund.

19 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
20 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
21 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
22 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
23 investment of that money, and money from any other source.

24 (4) Money in the fund at the close of the year shall remain in
25 the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.

26 Sec. 17. The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall
27 be expended solely for donations to the children's hospital of

1 Michigan to support the children's hospital of Michigan in
2 providing life-saving pediatric care, education, and research.

3 Sec. 19. The money in the fund that is available for
4 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money granted or
5 received as a gift or donation to the fund is available for
6 distribution upon appropriation.

7 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless House
8 Bill No. 6026 of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
